Boarder's Schedule 2011-2012

You have received the Temima overview calendar; this boarder's schedule will enable you to make your daughter's flight plans early in the year.

Boarding students who leave and return within the time parameters specified here will be counted "Excused" absent for the permitted periods. However, these absences **will** still count in the total number of absences. Please note that plenty of time should be allowed after leaving school to travel to the airport and arrive there 2 hours before the scheduled flight time. Atlanta is a very busy airport and security requirements are time consuming. ***Students whose absences exceed these parameters will not be excused for the classes missed.**

Yom Kippur/Succos/Simchas Torah Break (2 days of school missed)

Students may leave on Thursday, October 6 after 5:30 p.m. (end of school day). Students must be back for start of school (8:00 a.m.) on Monday, October 24. ****Please note: students will miss two days of school during this break, and will be required to make up all work from their absences. Students traveling to the West Coast may be permitted to leave at 3:00 p.m.**

Thanksgiving Break (no school missed)

Students may leave on Wednesday, November 23 after 5:30 p.m. (end of school day). Students must be back for start of school (8:00 a.m.) on Monday, November 28.

Winter Break (no school missed)

Students may leave on Thursday, December 22. Students must be back for the start of school (8:00 a.m.) on Monday, January 2.

Semester Break (no school missed)

Students may leave on Thursday, January 26 after 3:00 p.m. (after finals). Students must be back for start of school (8:00 a.m.) on Monday, January 30.

Pesach Break (no school missed**)

Students may leave on Sunday, April 1. Students must be back for start of school (8:00 a.m.) on Monday, April 16. ****Boarding students with exemplary attendance records may be permitted to leave after 5:30 PM on Thursday, March 29 (and miss one day of school) in order to spend an extra Shabbos at home. Please contact Mrs. Limor BEFORE making a ticket if you are interested in bringing your daughter home on Thursday.**
