

Advanced Placement & Joint Enrollment

Advanced Placement courses are offered to those students wishing to earn college credit while still in high school.

Students must take a College Board standardized examination to qualify for credits.

Each year the course selection is determined by the level of the class and the number of students interested.

The following Advanced Placement courses have been offered at Temima over the years.*

American History	Computer Science
Biology	English
Calculus	U.S. Government & Politics

Joint Enrollment with Georgia Perimeter College

Joint enrollment courses are offered to Juniors and Seniors and offer high school and college credits simultaneously.

Classes follow college semester schedules, and examinations are administered by individual college professors. To qualify, students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 in core studies, as well as a minimum SAT Verbal 530, Math 440. College credits are guaranteed for students who make a minimum of a C in the course. Students who make a D will only receive high school credit. Temima is fully accredited and students are eligible for Joint Enrollment courses.
