CLASS DESCRIPTION

Although Am Yisrael had many Neviim, the Gemorah tells us that only those prophecies that generations to come will need were written down. Therefore, every single word written in Melachim Beis carries with it a message to us. Although we will be learning this year about a time so removed from ours, a time when Bnei Yisrael lived in Eretz Yisrael with the Bais HaMikdash, when they had Neviim who told them how to be true G-d fearing Jews, they struggled much as we struggle today. Our mission this year will be to learn what happened then, during the time period that Melachim Beis spans, and to apply those ancient lessons to our lives today.
