Goal:

To understand the timely messages of key פרקים from ספר ישעיהו and ספר ירמיהו.

Objective:

This year we will אי"ה learn:

- Students will understand the roll of נביאים אחרונים in relationship to ספר מלכים.
- Students will know when and why these key פרקים are read as a הפטרה.
- Students will "own" key פסוקים from each פרק through memorization.
- Students will summarize each פרק in paragraph form and submit it as a נביא treasure.

Requirements:

- Students are required to attend class and take notes.
- Students must save their notes and keep them in an organized binder.
- Submit homework written neatly.
- Submit homework on time. Homework received on time has the opportunity to receive full credit.
- Save all quizzes and assignments.
- **Students must review notes consistently!**
- Students must make up notes when they are absent the day they arrive back to school if class does not meet on the day following her absence. For example, a student is absent on Monday and our next Bekius class meets on Thursday, Monday's work needs to be made up.
- Please use the נביא provided for you.

Tests:

- Quizzes or drills are given daily.
- Tests are cumulative. This means that there is a section on each test with questions from previous tests.
- If a student feels uncomfortable with the amount of material assigned for a test, she must speak to me two days after the test was scheduled. This gives me time to develop a study program with the student.
- Students are permitted to prepare study guides for a test. These outlines are submitted with the test and a student may receive points on her test for them.
- Study guides must be handed in on the day of the test.

Expectations of Derech Eretz:

- Only one person may talk at a time.
- Students must keep their work area neat. We want to respect our room as a beautiful Makom Torah.
- A student may call my home between 8:00 - 10:00 pm to discuss class.
- Please stand up when a teacher walks into the room.

Grades:

A student's Bekius grade consists of:

- Homework – Every homework is considered a quiz grade. I drop the lowest homework grade each quarter. Every 6 homework grades equals one test grade.
- Projects
- Tests
- Quizzes – Every 6 quizzes average into one test grade. I drop the lowest quiz grade. Quizzes may be announced or unannounced!
