



## Boarders' Calendar 2019-2020

You have received the Temima overview calendar; this boarders' schedule will enable you to make your daughter's flight plans early in the year. Please make your daughter's flight plans early so that she will be following this schedule.

### **Arrival:**

All boarders are expected to arrive in Atlanta *no later than* Sunday, August 25 in order to be settled in and ready for the first day of school, Monday, August 26.

### **Rosh Hashana Break:**

There is no Rosh Hashana break. Students will be coming home the next week.

### **Yom Kippur & Sukkos Break:**

Students may leave school on Monday, October 7 **after** 5:30 pm (or after her last class)\*, and should plan to return on Wednesday, October 23 in order to be present at Davening, 8:00 am, on Thursday, October 24.

### **Thanksgiving Break:**

Students may leave school on Wednesday, November 27 **after** 12:45 pm, and should plan to return on Sunday, December 1 in order to be present at Davening, 8:00 am, Monday, December 2.

### **Winter Break:**

Students may leave school no earlier than Friday, December 20 **after** 2:30 pm (or after her last class)\*, and should plan to return on Wednesday, January 1 in order to be present at Davening, 8:00 am, Thursday, January 2.

**Semester Break:**

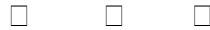
Students may leave school on Thursday, January 30 **after** exams, and should plan to return on Sunday, February 2 in order to be present at Davening, 8:00 am, Monday, February 3.

**Pesach Break:**

Students may leave school on Thursday, April 2 **after** noon (or after her last class)\*, and should plan to return on Sunday, April 19 in order to be present at Davening, 8:00 am, Monday, April 20.

**Shavuos Break:**

Students may leave on Thursday, May 28 after **noon**, and should plan to return **early** on Sunday, May 31 in order to be present at davening by 8:00 am.



When scheduling flights, make sure to allow plenty of time after leaving school for the student to travel to the airport and arrive there 2 hours before the scheduled flight time. **Allow a minimum of 3 hours between the end of classes and the departure time to account for travel to the airport and airport security.** Atlanta is a very busy airport and security requirements are time consuming.

**\*Boarding students will not be permitted to miss classes on these afternoons in order to catch their flights home. If there are no later flights available, please schedule your daughter's flight for first thing the next morning or when she can first travel.**
